RECYCLING & GARBAGE GUIDELINES

PICK-UP LOCATION: In front of premises by 6:00 AM.

RECYCLING: Please keep these two types of recyclables separated by either box or bag:

PLASTIC/METAL RECYCLING:

RIGID PLASTICS #1, #2, & #5 (Empty/Rinse)

- #1: Water/soda bottles • **NO** GLASS
- #2: Milk jugs, detergent bottles • **NO** film plastic
- #5: Tubs of yogurt, margarine • **NO** Styrofoam

Look for symbol:



METAL CANS (Emptied/Rinsed)

- Tin, aluminum, and bimetallic cans
- Aerosol spray cans (empty & caps removed)
- **NO** cans contaminated with toxic chemicals

PAPER/CARDBOARD RECYCLING:

PAPER

- Newspapers
- Office paper
- Paper bags
- Envelopes
- **NO** waxed paper
- **NO** metallic paper
- **NO** shredded paper
- **NO** soiled papers/tissues

CARDBOARD (please flatten)

- Corrugated (i.e. shipping boxes)
- Non-Corrugated (i.e. cereal & tissue boxes)
- **NO** milk/juice cartons
- **NO** packaging material (i.e. bubble wrap)
- **NO** wet or soiled cardboard
- **NO** egg cartons

GARBAGE/REFUSE: Containers must be covered, watertight, and not exceeding 50 lbs each.



BULK ITEMS/BUILDING MATERIALS: Four (4) items per household each bulk pick-up day. No railroad ties, dirt, concrete, hot tubs, or propane tanks. Mattresses/box springs must be in plastic mattress disposal bags.



LANDSCAPING DEBRIS: Small pieces of landscaping may be placed in sturdy plastic bags. Branches must be bundles/tied no larger than 4'x2'. Limit five (5) items per collection. Bag no heavier than 50 lbs. Loose yard waste will not be collected. Must be from homeowner performed work, not a hired contractor.
